

## **Tulane Law Exchange Program Participation Agreement**

## Upon acceptance to participate in a Tulane Law School Exchange Program, I hereby understand and agree to the following:

- 1. I will abide by the academic regulations and procedures of Tulane and the host institution, including but not limited to the Code of Student Conduct and the Honor Code.
- 2. I agree that Tulane has the right to enforce the Tulane University academic rules and regulations. Tulane University's Code of Student Conduct and the Tulane Law School Honor Code.
- 3. I understand that Tulane does not represent and cannot control the acts or omissions of the host institution or its affiliates connected with the academic foreign program.
- 4. While participating in this exchange program and/or traveling independently, I assume responsibility for my own health, safety, and academic performance. I agree Tulane is not responsible for any such property damage, personal injury and/or loss of life.
- 5. I understand that I must be covered by appropriate health, hospitalization and accident insurance providing coverage for medical treatment both within and outside the United States, with medical evacuation and repatriation coverage.
- 6. Tulane may take any action it considers warranted under the circumstances regarding a Participant's health and safety. I agree to release Tulane from any liability in connection with such action.
- 7. I recognize that I am required to attend all regularly scheduled classes at the host institution. Class absences in excess of those established by the host institution may result in prohibition of receiving credit for the program. If a participant not eligible to continue the program, he/she will be sent home at his/her own expense with no refund of fees.
- 8. I have considered the challenges of cultural adjustment, different medical practices and ways to manage any pre-existing conditions while overseas. The designated Tulane Program Director, has the authority to terminate Program participation of a student whose continuation would be detrimental to him/herself, to others, or to the University. Return travel and any other expenses due to such Program termination are to be paid by the student.
- 9. I will accept my housing and living arrangements and abide by the regulations governing the conduct of students in these lodgings.
- 10. Tulane will seek to reasonably accommodate students with physical or learning disabilities wherever possible for overseas programs. I will work with the Tulane Program Coordinator to try to accommodate my requests. Not all accommodations for disabilities may be available at the program location, or available in the same way.
- 11. I agree this Participation Agreement for the Tulane Law School Exchange Programs will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Louisiana.
- 12. I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to meet all visa and travel requirements for my program location.
