Additional Notes

*Tuition and fees have increased an average of 3.68% in the last five prior years.

**3L students will have an added \$900 budget component to cover the costs of taking one bar exam and one character and fitness test, split evenly in the fall and spring semesters.

***Allowance for “miscellaneous” is to help cover costs such as the optional campus parking (\$520-\$575 tentatively set for 2024-2025) permit.

****Allowance for “health/medical” is to help cover costs such as those associated with first aid supplies and medical insurance.

*****Actual living expenses vary based on an individual’s choices of housing, transportation method, etc. Students may contact the Office of Admissions for assistance in researching local housing options. Financial aid consists of grants, scholarships, loans, and other resources, and is limited to the estimated Cost of Attendance.

*****Federal student loans have origination fees that come out of them prior to disbursement (1.057% for Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans, 4.228% for Federal Direct Graduate Plus loans. They typically change Oct. 1st of each year).
